Haltham Village Fun Dog Show - Sunday 7 July 2019

First, a huge well done and massive thank you to Dawn Mutti for the idea and judging, and also to the team of villagers, volunteers and those who donated their time, equipment and most of all that enormous amount of food for the organisation and theirs support that made the show such an enjoyable event. Speed Limit

Sean Mathews continues to monitor the speed limit situation through the village and also to liaise with neighbouring village representatives. Our aim is to have the limit reduced to 40 mph from the top of the chicane to the outskirts of the main village. Possible actions include radar monitoring to build up evidence of excessive speeding, lobbying ELDC and erecting radar "Your speed" signs.

Parochial Church Council (PCC)

Helen Huthwaite is our representative on the PCC (that covers Haltham, Kirkby-on-Bain, Tattershall and Coningsby) with the main activity being care of St Benedict's graveyard. St Benedict's Church itself is the responsibility of the separate Church Conservation Trust (CCT). Helen will be seeking the trimming of the trees overhanging the adjacent properties at the entrance to the graveyard and permission to improve the grass path to the church entrance. Please let Helen know if you have other concerns for the PCC.

Village Green

The Dog Show showed good use of the Village Green and we have been granted funds to improve it. This will include erecting a fence on the pub car park side of the Green but there is a need to clarify the boundary on that side and we are in discussions with the Marmion Arms car park owners to confirm the exact boundary using title deeds etc.

No comments, amendments or objections were raised on the draft Standing Orders and so these have now been ratified.
